Job Description

As a lower-level math instructor, you will be responsible for instructing students through both Algebra 1 and Geometry. Algebra 1 covers expressions, systems of equations, functions, real numbers, inequalities, exponents, polynomials, radical and rational expressions. Geometry curriculum includes helping students understand topics ranging from points, lines, and planes to logic and reasoning, angles, slopes, triangles, polygons, circles, volume, and area. Teachers will be responsible for differentiating instruction within their classrooms to meet individual student's needs. Project-based learning is encouraged and teachers should have a clear vision for methods of instruction and classroom management.

Other responsibilities include residential duties, serving as an academic advisor, and leading in the outdoor pursuits program which may include backpacking, rock climbing, kayaking, skiing, and mountain biking among other activities. Compensation is based on teaching experience and education and includes room and board on our beautiful 60-acre campus fourteen miles from Durango.
